Before You Begin

- Check your packing slip to verify that you have all the necessary items.
- Make sure you have a standard Phillips screwdriver.
- You can mount the chassis in either a **2-post telco rack** or a **4-post server rack**.
- If your rack requires its own screws and/or nuts, then use those instead.



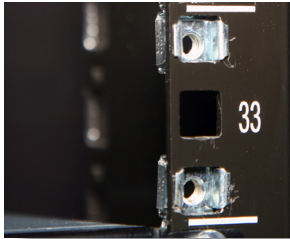

- Because the NX-1700 has more than one possible physical chassis, the photos may not look like the model you have. However, all NX-1700s use the same method of attachment.
- This uses 1 RU of rack space.
- The appliance ships with four M5 x 5/8" screws and four cage nuts.
- Installation is easier if one person holds the chassis in position while another attaches the screws.

To mount the NX-1700 into the telco or server rack:

1. Attach the cage nuts to the rear of the front rack posts.



2. Use the screws to secure the chassis to the outside front of the rack

When using two screws on each side, secure the top and bottom holes for greater stability.
